

Our Logo, Mission Statement and Prayer.



The Ovingham partnership is named after an Augustine priory from the fourteenth century. Two stone carvings from this are now located in St Mary's church, providing a link to our heritage. One carving bears a ring of eight circles linked by arms to a central rosette of flower.

Our church names in the logo show our individuality as parishes as well as our common identity in the new partnership. The maroon colour and the symbol in the centre echo the forward in hope together in hope logo and reflect our continuing journey.
